This project is to upgrade the kitchen to the requirements set forth by Northern Health and the Environment Health Officer to continue operating and provide healthy meal preparation for the tenants.

Subsequent to the presentation by Brad, the Kitimat Gyro Club has made a commitment to make a donation to the project in the amount of \$2,530.00 for the purchase of the Wayfair range hoods.
